The following resolution was offered by Ackerman and seconded by Lewis.

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes that it is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare to maintain and improve the Webberville Consolidated Drain pursuant to Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, and that improvement of the Drain is required to protect against periodic flooding in Village of Webberville; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the lands to be benefited by the maintenance and improvement of the Webberville Consolidated Drain is located within the Village of Webberville; and

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes that it will be subject to assessment at large to pay for a percentage of the costs of the Webberville Consolidated Drain.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, the Village authorizes the signing of a petition for maintenance and improvement of the Webberville Consolidated Drain.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village President and Village Clerk are authorized to sign the above referenced petition and to forward a copy of the signed petition and this resolution to the Ingham County Drain Commissioner.





**PETITION FOR CLEANING OUT, RELOCATING, WIDENING, DEEPENING,
STRAIGHTENING, TILING, EXTENDING, IMPROVING, RELOCATING ALONG A
HIGHWAY, ADDING BRANCHES, AND PROVIDING STRUCTURES AND DEVICES
THAT WILL PROPERLY PURIFY OR IMPROVE THE FLOW,
PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN DRAIN CODE OF 1956, AS AMENDED**

WEBBERVILLE CONSOLIDATED DRAIN

To the Ingham County Drain Commissioner:

The undersigned petitioner, Village of Webberville, located within Ingham County, Michigan, hereby petitions for the cleaning out, relocating, widening, deepening, straightening, tiling, extending, improving, relocating along a highway, adding branches, and providing structures and devices that will properly purify or improve the flow of the Webberville Consolidated Drain, located within Village of Webberville and Leroy Township, Ingham County, Michigan. This Petition is made pursuant to Chapter 8 of the Michigan Drain Code, MCL 280.1, et seq.

The petitioner is a municipality that will be liable to assessments at large for at least a percentage of the total amount to be assessed for the cost of the maintenance and improvement of the Webberville Consolidated Drain. This petition has been authorized by the Village of Webberville's governing body. A copy of the Resolution of the Village of Webberville is attached hereto.

Your petitioner further shows that maintaining and improving the established Drain is required to protect against periodic flooding and is necessary for the public health, convenience and welfare of the Village of Webberville.
